<i>Date:</i>	Sunday 24 th October 2010
<i>Time:</i>	Races: Sun – 8am – 3pm (TBC once team entries are finalised)
<i>Team Captains Briefing</i>	7:45am at Registration/Finish Line tent (near the Rowing Club)
<i>Location:</i>	Clarence River, Memorial Park (end of Prince St)
<i>Site Facilities:</i>	Markets, entertainment, food stalls and toilets
<i>Race Schedule:</i>	Will be distributed on Monday 18 th October 2010
<i>Race Distances:</i>	200m sprints
<i>Boats:</i>	4 -6 fibreglass boats (depending upon numbers) matching boats
<i>Paddles:</i>	Only IDBF spec paddles (202a) will be accepted
<i>Team Composition</i>	Community Mixed and Schools Mixed (must have a maximum of 50% male paddlers)
<i>Category Criteria:</i>	All teams comprise a minimum 16 paddlers to a maximum of 20 paddlers (drummer and steerer to be provided by DBNSW) As per standard DBNSW definitions (which can be found on the website)
<i>Team Composition</i>	As per standard DBNSW definitions (which can be found on the website)
<i>Qualifying for Finals</i>	Points are allocated on placings in heat results and added together to form finals qualifications. If more than 6 teams qualify, the times of teams on equal points will be added to identify the 4-6 fastest qualifying teams..
<i>Rules of Racing</i>	AusDBF Race Rules and Regulations with NSW Local adaptations
<i>Safety:</i>	Sweeps are responsible for crew safety and must be familiar with DBNSW Inc safety guidelines (refer DBNSW website). Weak or non-swimmers MUST wear a life vest.
<i>Sweeps:</i>	All Community and Schools teams will be provided with an accredited steerer and drummer.
<i>First Aid:</i>	St Johns Ambulance personal or similar will be on duty
<i>Uniforms:</i>	All teams must wear a distinguishable uniform (e.g. caps, t-shirts etc)
<i>Clean-up:</i>	All teams are requested to clean up their area at the end of the day.
<i>Security:</i>	Teams are responsible for the security of their valuables. BE WARY.
<i>Insurance:</i>	\$3.00 per person for personal accident insurance which cover all competitors for competition day and one (1) training session prior
<i>Alcohol:</i>	Dragon Boats NSW Inc has zero tolerance policy. Alcohol and water do not mix. If any individual is found to be consuming alcohol either during training or at the competition the entire team will be disqualified.
<i>Behaviour:</i>	Dragon Boats NSW Inc has a zero tolerance policy for bad behaviour. Bad behaviour will not be tolerated either on land or water, any teams not following the steerers instructions or any officials will be disqualified.
<i>Marquee's:</i>	Teams wishing to bring their own marquee's for shade are to advise Clarence Community Events of size (dimension) no later than Friday 08 th October. Team marquee's will be all allocated spots, so you will need to check with organisers when you arrive for your allocated location.
